### **Funding Priority Investments**

#### **Immigration Serving Organizations & Programs**

(Noncitizens: includes permeant residents, undocumented, asylum seekers, and refugees)

COVID-19 Impact	Programs/Strategies	Equitable Outcomes	Amount
Decreased economic security for noncitizens	<ul> <li>Navigation services to coordinate access to resources across providers and agencies</li> <li>Direct financial assistance to stabilize families in crisis</li> <li>Enrollment assistance for public benefits</li> <li>Connect those eligible to work with training and employment opportunities</li> </ul>	Create safety net to support family stability and improve financial security	\$1.5 Million
Decreased access to pathways for citizenship	<ul> <li>Outreach and education on immigration rights</li> <li>Legal representation for immigrants at risk of deportation</li> </ul>	Improve family financial security & expand opportunities for citizenship
