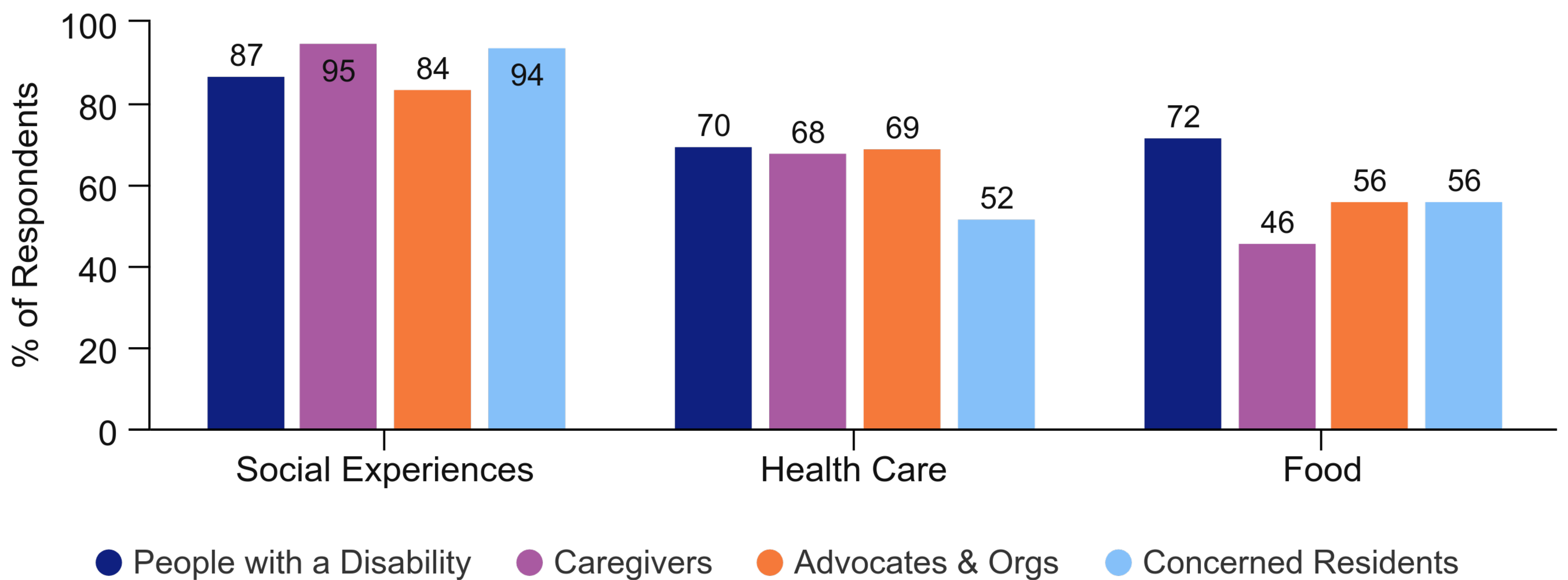
ONLINE SURVEY RESULTS INFOGRAPHIC

Sample

- ✓ 415 respondents shared impacts, concerns & ideas
- ✓ 53% live with a disability and 24% identified as caregivers
- ✓ 31% Hispanic, 71% female, and 74% age 45 or older

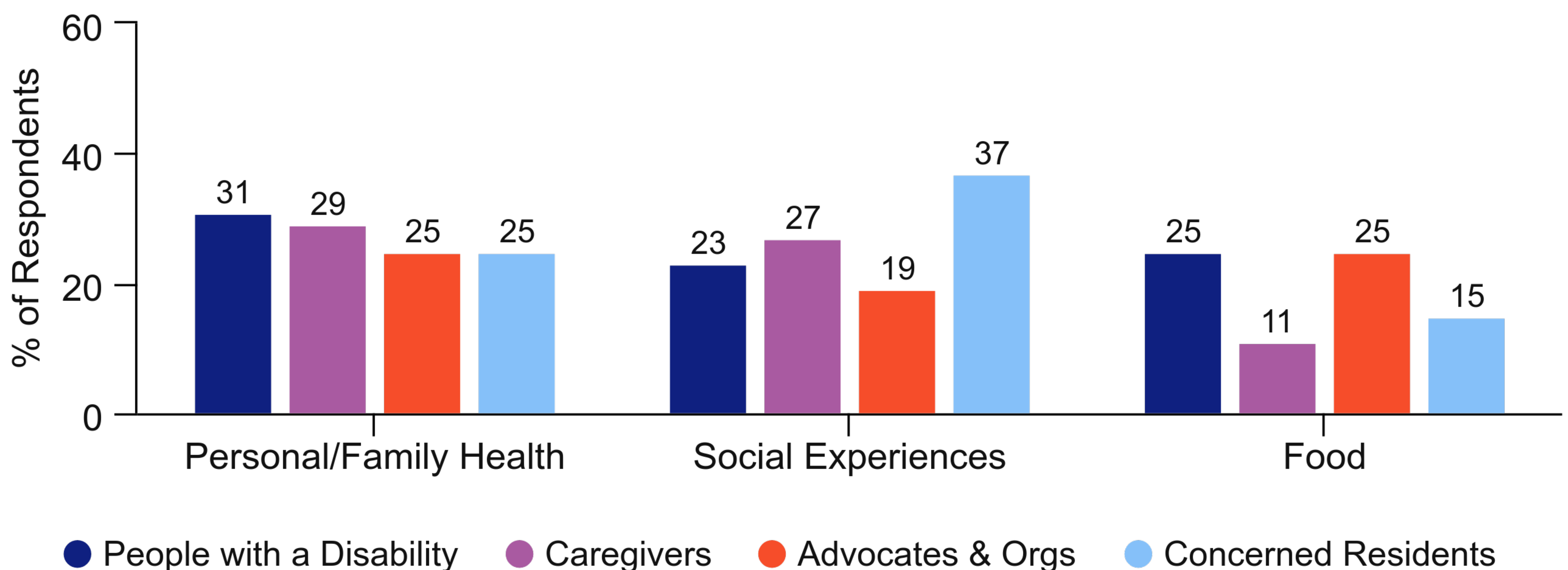
Impacts of COVID-19

Respondents selected all of the dimensions of their life that had been impacted by the pandemic from the following options: Digital Technology, Education, Employment, Food, Health Care and Medical Supplies, Housing, Social Experiences, Transportation, and Voting. Social Experiences, Health Care, and Food were selected most frequently.



Top Concerns

Respondents were asked to provide open-ended feedback on their top concerns when planning for the next 6 to 12 months. Responses were coded into categories. Personal/Family Health, Social Experiences, and Food were the three concerns respondents mentioned most frequently.
