



## **An Eviction has been filed against you, now what?**

**You should do the following as soon as possible.**

### **1. Call Texas Rio Grande Legal Aid for **FREE** legal help**

Texas Rio Grande Legal Aid (TRLA) provides **FREE** legal help through San Antonio's Right to Counsel Program.

### **2. Apply for Texas Rent Relief**

If you are unable to pay rent, you may qualify for The Texas Rent Relief Program. The program offers up to 15 months of rental and utility assistance for those facing eviction. The program will seal eviction records for people they help. This means filing will be kept confidential. To learn more visit <https://texasrentrelief.com/> or call 1-833-989-7368 (1-833-9TX-RENT).

### **3. Appear in court on your court date**

To avoid automatic judgement against you, you must appear in court the day of your hearing. Your hearing may be virtual or in person. You can request a virtual hearing by calling the court.
