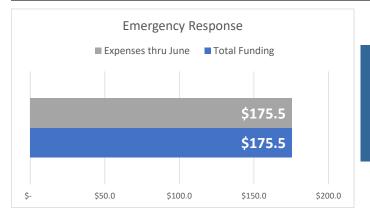
Variance Explanations

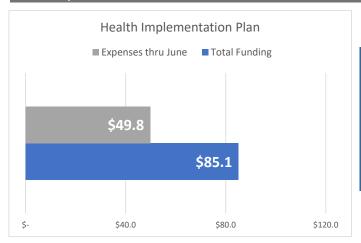
Emergency Response

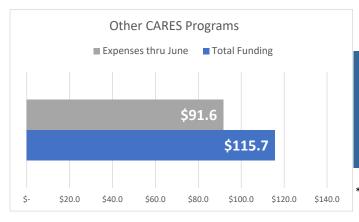

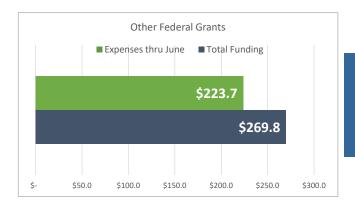

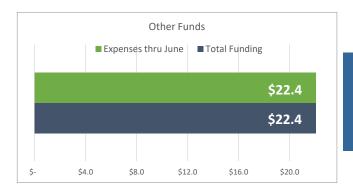
